- Maintain student culture which embraces reading through the

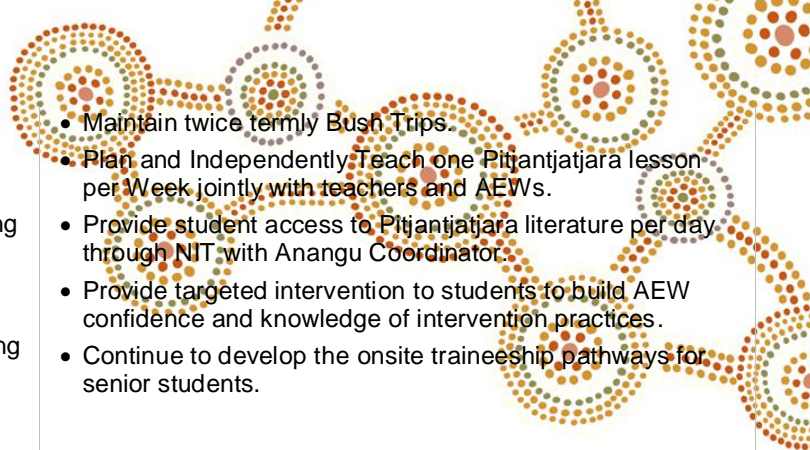
Empower Anangu Culture and Language

- Commit to the training and skill development of AEWs.





Implementation and explicit teaching of the Big 6.

- Continued delivery of effective literacy pedagogy within a structured, agreed and uninterrupted English block
- Build confidence in writing by developing student understanding of text type, structural features and appropriate language choices through explicit teaching of the 4 cycles of writing. Moderation regular
- Encourage daily creative writing through interesting and exciting prompts.

Effective numeracy pedagogies:

- Create a student culture which embraces mathematics and encourages risk taking through Gamefying and use of concrete materials and digital technologies for engagement.
- Maintain effective numeracy pedagogy within a structured, agreed and uninterrupted Maths block.
- Implement more timely, relevant and appropriate Assessment tools to track and monitor student growth in Mathematics.

Effective teaching and learning:

- Continue to promote a whole site culture and language around achievement data sets and cycles of review and improvement.
- Provide regular and timely feedback through formative and summative assessment.
- Regularly engage in professional development through PLCs, staff meetings and polycom/teleconference.

- Maintain twice termly Bush Trips.
- Plan and Independently Teach one Pitjantjatjara lesson per Week jointly with teachers and AEWs.
- Provide student access to Pitjantjatjara literature per day through NIT with Anangu Coordinator.
- Provide targeted intervention to students to build AEW confidence and knowledge of intervention practices.
- Continue to develop the onsite traineeship pathways for senior students.
